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## **1. Collect your materials**

- a. What artefact station sparks your interest?
- b. What crafting materials do you need for your diorama?

## **2. Analyze your artefacts**

- a. Who would have used your artefacts?
- b. What would the artefact have been used for?
- c. What is the context of your artefact with other artefacts at the station?

## **3. Build your diorama**

- a. What background will you use?
- b. Will you include multiple artefact replicas or focus on one artefact?

## **4. Write your story on the back of your diorama**

- a. What story do you want to share with your diorama? (Non-fiction or fiction)

## **5. Share your diorama with family and friends**

- a. How can we share the story of our diorama with our friends and family?
