Alberta Projectile Points Word Search

Projectile Points are a common artefact found in Alberta. A projectile point is an object which would be hafted to a weapon capable of being thrown or projected. Projectile points are helpful indicators of a sites occupation.

This method of dating is known as *typological dating*.

Projectile points fall into three main typological categories.

Spear Points, Dart Points and Arrow Heads.
